4. Remind your friends, family, and co-workers to look for and reclaim their lost pet at Winnebago County Animal Services.
5. Vote for Winnebago County Animal Services again in October during the Community Engagement competition. More information to come later.



🐾 PET ADOPTION IS A GREAT OPTION

Winnebago County Animal Services wants to help you pick the best pet for your family, and we encourage adopters to include the entire family in the process. Introducing a new pet into your home is an important decision and long-term commitment.

When you visit Winnebago County Animal Services, knowing the following information will facilitate the process for you.

ADOPTION GUIDELINES FOR WCAS

All other Rescue Groups will have their own adoption rules to follow, so please make sure to check with them. Go to www.wcasrock.org to see a complete list of the animals that are up for adoption.

- You must be at least 18 years old to adopt.
- Bring a state-issued photo ID with current address. If ID doesn't have the current address, bring a current phone, electric bill or a mortgage statement.
- If you are interested in adopting a dog and you already own a dog, we allow you to do an introduction at our facility once your application is approved.
- Talk with your landlord prior to visiting the shelter about the type of pet you are considering. Please bring along your landlord's name and phone number. A copy of your lease or notarized letter stating you may have a pet will expedite the process for you.
- Adoption fees: \$110 for dogs; \$40 for cats 1 year and older; \$85 for kittens under a year; all cats and dogs seven years or older are ½ off the regular adoption fee.

Winnebago County Animal Services is looking for adopters with a history of responsible pet ownership which includes:

- A reasonable history of current rabies vaccinations and pet license.
- Little or no history of animal complaints.
- No history of animal neglect or abuse.
- A reasonable history representing the long-time commitment of pet ownership.

In some cases, you can take your adopted pet home the same day. Unaltered pets will be spayed or neutered the next business day and can be picked the day of surgery.

All adoptions include:

- Spay or neuter surgery.
- Age and species appropriate vaccinations such as distemper, parvo, kennel cough, and rabies.
- Microchip identification in the event your pet is lost.
- A card for a free follow-up exam at your own veterinarian.
- All dogs 6 months and older are heartworm tested.
- We also send you home with a bag of Science Diet pet food to get your started.

🐾 DOG FAIR FEES:

- \$4.00 per person - \$3.00 per dog
- No charge for children 10 and under
- No advanced registration needed



🐾 RULES & RECOMMENDATIONS:

- One dog per person, please.
- All dogs must be at least four months old and current with their rabies tag or owner must provide proof. This will be checked at the entrance.
- All dogs must be leashed (preferred leash length of no longer than 6 feet) at all times unless dog is participating in special event demo area. No flexi-leads.
- Be courteous and responsible; please scoop up after your pet. Baggies are available at entrance table.
- Use good judgement regarding the temperament of your pet so that this event will be enjoyable for everyone. Please do not bring a dog whose behavior could be dangerous to others. Also, female dogs in heat should not attend this event.
- At the discretion of the event officials, pets or people whose behavior is unruly or might prove to be hazardous to other pets or people will be refused entry or asked to leave.
